## Minimum Salaries for Skilled IT posts offered to non-EEA migrants or advertised as part of the Resident Labour Market Test

The table overleaf lists the minimum salaries which must be paid by firms to non-EEA workers engaged by them.

With the exception of ICTs, these posts must also have been advertised at this rate for at least two weeks, as part of the “Resident Labour Market Test”, in set locations including at Jobcentre Plus. This is to ensure that there is no UK or EEA candidate available to fill a post that a firm intends to fill with a non EEA worker.

If you:

- See/apply for a job advertised at a rate below that listed below OR
- Have evidence that ICTs or migrant workers at your firm are being paid below the rate listed for their post
